## **Fiscal Analysis**

The FA1 on SB 752 has no further fiscal or revenue considerations for the state. The original impact for the engrossed version is below.

SB 752 expands the scope of a misdemeanor. The penalty can be incarceration in jail and/or a fine. Expanding the amount of people eligible for a conviction could increase the associated fine revenue for the courts as well as several state agencies which receive revenue from these fines. The ultimate impact is dependent upon how many individuals are convicted, required to pay a fine, and the amount of the fine they are required to pay.
