## **Research Analysis**

SB756 requires medical marijuana packaging to be plain, opaque, designed to maximize shelf life, tamper-evident, and protect the product from contamination.

SB756 also requires medical marijuana packaging to not depict shapes, text, or designs appealing to children and to not bear a reasonable resemblance to any commercially available product.

Further, the measure requires all medical marijuana products to be in child-resistant packaging as required by the federal Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970.
