Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for SB756 makes changes to sections 14 and 18 of the “Unity Bill”, Enrolled House Bill 2612.

SECTION 14:

The measure deletes language prohibiting a publicly traded company from holding a medical marijuana business license.

SECTION 18:

Requires medical marijuana packaging to be plain, opaque, designed to maximize shelf life, tamper-evident, and protect the product from contamination.

Requires medical marijuana packaging to not depict shapes, text, or designs appealing to children and to not bear a reasonable resemblance to any commercially available product.

Further, the measure requires all medical marijuana products to be in child-resistant packaging as required by the federal Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970.
