SB 759 prohibits physicians recommending medical marijuana use from examining patients at a dispensary, offering a discount or other thing of value to a patient for agreeing to use a particular caregiver or dispensary, holding an economic interest in any enterprise involved in the sale of medical marijuana, or accepting payment from a caregiver, dispensary, processor, or grower.
