**Research Analysis**

SB 765 adds that smoking or vaping marijuana in a public places is prohibited. The measure lists places affected, including public transportation, indoor workplaces, and child care facilities. The measure allows higher education institutions to be designated as marijuana free. The measure allows for marijuana smoking or vaping in a medical research or treatment center if marijuana smoking or vaping is integral to the research or treatment.
