Research Analysis

SB 810 creates an Oklahoma Wine Industry Development Commission, whose members will represent small farm wineries in Oklahoma and who will be by the commissioner of agriculture. The measure also creates an Oklahoma Grape and Wine Industry Development Revolving Fund, which will consist of appropriations, grants, gifts, and supplemental fees added to ABLE Commission licenses.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 810 creates the Oklahoma Grape and Wine Industry Development Revolving Fund at the Dept. of Ag which will consist of: appropriations, grants, gifts, and supplemental fees added to ABLE licenses (the supplemental fees do not currently exist). The measure also creates the Oklahoma Wine Industry Development Commission. Members are not provided compensation or travel reimbursement. There is no initial fiscal impact on the state unless the Legislature appropriates general revenue monies into the revolving fund.
