Research Analysis

The CS for SB 831 requires DHS to appoint an administrative law judge (ALJ) to conduct a hearing within 30 days of receiving notice that a child care facility is protesting the revocation or denial of issuance of a license. If the department issues an emergency order revoking the license of a facility, the person to whom the order was issued will be entitled to a hearing before an ALJ within three business days of the department receiving the request for a hearing.
