Research Analysis

SB 950 creates a new regulatory scheme under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to license pet stores that sell dogs. The measure sets out certain requirements for dogs, including that:

- the store acquire dogs in a certain way;
- the dogs are at least 8 weeks old;
- the dogs are microchipped; and
- the dogs are not sold to minors.

The measure grants ODAFF the authority to:

- set the license fee;
- refuse or revoke pet store licenses; and
- use the newly created Pet Store License Revolving Fund to enforce the provisions of the act.

The measure creates penalties for first, second and third violations at \$500; \$2,500; and \$10,000, respectively.
