Research Analysis

SB 953 authorizes the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to disburse, at the beginning of the calendar year, one-half of the contracted amount for services to freestanding child abuse multidisciplinary teams that are functioning effectively. The bill also provides that any funds left over at the end of the contract period will revert back to the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 953 953 authorizes the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to advance payments equal to one half of the contracted amount to functioning freestanding multidisciplinary teams at the beginning of each calendar year to teams from the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Team Account (CAMTA). The measure also stipulates that funds not used by a freestanding multidisciplinary teams will revert back to the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account (CAMA).
