Research Analysis

The Subcommittee Recommendation for SB 953 authorizes the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, during state fiscal year 2019, to disburse to each freestanding multidisciplinary team the remaining contracted amount awarded to the team and requires the team provide the Commission with monthly documentation of expenses and activity data. The measure also provides that, beginning January 1, 2020, the Commission may disburse the contracted amount at the beginning of the calendar year to teams that are determined to be functioning effectively. Any funds remaining at the end of the contract period will revert back to the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account.

Fiscal Analysis

The Subrec to SB 953 authorizes the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to advance annual payments of the contracted amount to functioning freestanding multidisciplinary teams at the beginning of each calendar year to teams from the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Team Account (CAMTA). The measure also stipulates that funds not used by a freestanding multidisciplinary teams will revert back to the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account (CAMA).
