Bill Analysis

HB 1051 directs each school district board of education to conduct an annual fitness assessment each school year for students in grades 3-12 beginning in the 2021-2022 school year. The measure outlines the required content of the assessment. The results of the annual assessment must be submitted to the State Board of Education without identifying information, and the results are also to be sent to the parent or guardian of a student. The measure also requires the State Department of Education to adopt a fitness assessment instrument which adequately expresses the most current and widely accepted best practices in the areas of student health and physical education. It directs the Department to analyze the performance results and identify certain correlations, such as correlations between the results and student obesity, disciplinary problems or attendance levels. It directs the Department to report these findings annually beginning September 1, 2021, to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Oklahoma State Department of Health. It also directs the State Board of Education to submit an annual report on the compliance status of each district to the Governor beginning October 1, 2020.
