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**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for HB 1308 amends the definition of “threatening behavior” in relation to schools to include written threats to the school and further requires such behavior to pose an imminent risk of physical harm. Threats to school property are removed from the definition. The measure further requires officers and employees of a school district to comply with federal and state laws as they apply to reporting threatening behavior. Additionally, schools are required by the measure to develop a policy to determine if a student who engages in threatening behavior to complete a behavioral threat assessment.

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
