Bill Analysis

HB 1310 requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to coordinate with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to provide REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Cards to all offenders that do not possess a state-issued identification card or driver license upon their release. Identification cards are to be issued and replaced in the same manner as driver licenses in this state. If no other form of identification is available, DPS must authorize the use of a DOC-issued consolidated record card to serve as a valid identification document to obtain a REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Card. The REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Cards is valid for a period of two years from the month of issuance for a fee of \$12.50 and are nonrenewable.
