Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for HB 2126 specifies that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) shall be the sole entity, outside of the law enforcement entity that was targeted by a complaint, to review and/or monitor complaints of excessive uses of force. OSBI may only review the complaint at the invitation of the law enforcement agency targeted by the complaint. The OSBI is authorized by the measure to contract with law enforcement agencies to perform the review and/or monitoring functions outlined in this measure.

Fiscal Analysis

Full Year Impact: OSBI estimates the agency will require an additional 12 FTE at a cost of \$1.2 million annually

The CS for HB2126 authorizes the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to review and monitor allegations/complaints of excessive use of force made against commissioned law enforcement officers for the purpose of determining compliance with current investigative procedures, standards and law. OSBI shall be the sole agency outside of the law enforcement agency that is the subject of an allegation/complaint, authorized to review and/or monitor such complaints. Review and/or monitoring shall be done only upon request by the law enforcement agency subject to the excessive for allegation/complaint or the office of the district attorney in the county in which the allegation/complaint occurred.

The measure also authorizes OSBI to contract with Oklahoma law enforcement agencies and municipal, county or state governmental entities to perform these review and/or monitoring functions. It directs all funds received as a result of any contract with OSBI to be deposited in the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations Revolving Fund (200)
