**Floor Substitute (FS)**

The FS for HB 2601 states that the sales tax on medical marijuana collected by vendors shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. The measure also strikes language prohibiting the storage of personal data, as defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), by the Oklahoma State Department of Health.
