Bill Analysis

HB 2880 states that reports, statements, memoranda, proceedings, findings, and other records submitted to or generated by any peer review committee or peer reviewer shall be considered privileged and not subject to discovery or a subpoena. The design professional who retains, employs, designates or appoints the peer reviewer or peer review committee is the holder of the privilege established by this section. Peer reviewers and members of a peer review committee are exempted from any civil liability arising out of compliance with the provisions of this measure.
