Bill Analysis

HB 3096 reduces the number of weeks for which unemployment benefits may be paid. The measure authorizes a person to collect benefits for 12 weeks if the state's average unemployment rate is at or below 5.5%, with an additional week for each 0.5% increment above 5.5%, up to a maximum of 20 weeks.
