**Bill Analysis**

HB 3195 requires all sheriffs, jailers, prison keepers, and their deputies who have custody of a person who is the subject of an immigration detainer request to comply with any request made in the immigration detainer request provided by the federal government and to inform persons identified in the immigration detainer request that they are being held as a result of the request. If a person provides proof of citizenship, as outlined in the measure, sheriffs, jailers, and prison keepers are not required to hold the person.
