## **Bill Analysis**

HB 3223 allows entities authorized to dissect, operate upon, and experiment on bodies, to retain tissue from bodies and to donate the tissue to a person or entity for the purpose of training a dog to search for human remains. Tissue transferred to such a person or entity shall not be transferred, sold, or used for any other purpose than training dogs to search for human remains.
