**Bill Analysis**

HB 3253 authorizes the board of county commissioners to determine how many years of service may qualify a full-time county employee for a continuing education program. The measure expands the continuing education program to include other in-state or out-of-state programs or courses relevant to the employee's responsibilities. The measure also makes an employee ineligible for the program if he or she has been formally disciplined prior to submitting an application.
