**Bill Analysis**

HB 3289 modifies the licensure requirements related to scrap metal dealing, alcoholic beverages, motor vehicle dealing, used motor vehicle and parts dealing, and medical micropigmentation. The measure prohibits an applicant from receiving a license if they have been convicted or pled guilty to a felony substantially relating to the licensed practice and poses a reasonable threat to public safety.
