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**Bill Analysis**

HB 3326 creates the Seizure Safe Schools Act. The measure requires every school that has a student enrolled who has a seizure disorder to have at least 1 employee who is trained to recognize the signs of a seizure and trained to administer or assist with the self-administration of seizure rescue medicine. A parent or guardian must provide the school with a written statement authorizing the school employee to administer the medicine, provide a written statement from the student's health care provider with details about the medicine and the student's condition and provide the school with medicine in a sealed package. The parent or guardian must coordinate with the designated employee to create a seizure action plan. The bill also requires every public school to provide an age-appropriate seizure education program to all students.
