**Bill Analysis**

HB 3330 creates the Sergeant Schoolfield Line of Duty Disability Act. The measure modifies disability pension standards for members of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System (OPPRS) by requiring the Board of Trustees for OPPRS to determine if a police officer that sustains an injury through a violent act, while in the performance of their duties as a police officer, is 100% disabled and entitled to a 100% normal disability benefit. The measure also amends the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act to include a safe harbor clause that allows the measure to be treated as a nonfiscal retirement bill.
