**Floor Substitute (FS)**

The FS for SB 1018 authorizes stretcher vans to carry oxygen. The measure also prohibits the Commissioner of Health from adopting Federal Specification KKK-A-1822, which is the federal definition of an ambulance, and applying the definition to stretcher vans licensed on or after September 6, 2016. Stretcher vans licensed on or after September 6, 2016, must meet Ambulance Manufacturers Division Standards 004, 012 and 013, and must pass corresponding safety tests.
