**Bill Analysis**

SB 1082 requires carriers providing coverage for insulin to cap the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for an insulin prescription at an amount that shall not exceed \$100.00 per 30-day supply. The Insurance Commissioner is directed by the measure to ensure all carriers comply with the provisions of the measure and to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the measure as well as comply with federal law. Carriers are not prohibited from requiring a person to pay less than \$100.00 for a 30-day supply of insulin.

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
