Bill Analysis

SB 1083 as introduced provides district attorneys with greater discretion as it pertains to sentencing any person convicted for a hate crime. Previous law required a person convicted of a hate crime to be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor on the first offense and a felony on second or subsequent convictions.
