Bill Analysis

SB 1092 modifies the income eligibility requirement for a student to qualify for Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program. Beginning in the school year 2025-2026, a student enrolled in a public or private school or who is between the ages 13 and 15 and educated by other means will not be found to be in financial need if the federal adjusted gross income of the student's parents' exceeds \$75,000.00 per year. Beginning in the school year 2029-2030, a student may qualify for the program if the student's parents' income does not exceed \$80,000.00.
