**Bill Analysis**

SB 1097 requires a student wishing to pursue a virtual education to enroll in the full-time virtual education program offered by his or her resident school district beginning with the 2022-2023 school year if the resident district offers a virtual education program that is equal in scope and content to an existing virtual charter school sponsored by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to students already enrolled in a virtual charter school.
