SB 1104 adds the crime of domestic assault and battery against a pregnant woman with knowledge of pregnancy with said assault resulting in a miscarriage to the list of 85% crimes. A person convicted of this crime shall be required to serve 85% of his or her sentence prior to becoming eligible for consideration for parole.
