Bill Analysis

SB 1107 defines “victimless crime” and “victim” in the Oklahoma Criminal Code. A victimless crime occurs when there is a criminal act that has no direct victim and involves only the perpetrator or occurs between consenting adults. A victim is defined as a person harmed or aggrieved by a crime committed.
