**Bill Analysis**

SB 1119 directs the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to create and publish a report titled the “Future of Oklahoma Industry and Labor (FOIL) Report.” The report shall analyze and describe current and predictable trends of the State of Oklahoma’s jobs, industries and labor workforce as well as contain an interactive map. The measure also requires the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, the Department of Labor, the Department of Career and Technology Education, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the Center for Economic Management Research at the University of Oklahoma, and the Center for Economic and Business Development at Southwestern Oklahoma State University to work in collaboration with the Department of Commerce to develop the report.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FY’21 Impact: \$100,000.00

Full Year Impact: \$200,000.00

The legislation requires the Department to develop an annual report and an interactive map detailing certain job and industry trends. The Department of Commerce has stated that it will require one FTE to create and maintain the interactive map, along with several software licenses to be used by the coordinating agencies listed in the legislation. The server to hold the mapping software and data would be rented from OMES at a cost of \$8,000 per month.
