Bill Analysis

SB 1123 requires the parents of a child enrolling in a public school district to disclose whether the student has received or is receiving mental health services from a mental health facility beginning with the 2020-2021 school year. Within five days of the disclosure, designated school personnel shall meet with the student and representatives of the mental health facility to determine whether the student will need special accommodations. The meeting may take place in person, over the phone, teleconference, or via videoconference. Disclosures made to the school district shall comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
