Bill Analysis

SB 1124 repeals statutory language requiring a motorist to have in his or her possession at all times while operating a vehicle either a registration certificate, true copy of rental or lease documentation, registration certificate issued for a replacement vehicle, temporary receipt printed upon a self-initiated electronic renewal of a registration via the Internet, or a cab card. The measure requires commercial vehicles, instead of all vehicles, to carry these forms of registration at all times.
