Bill Analysis

SB 114 authorizes golf courses and marinas to own and sell from a liquor store on its property in accordance with rules promulgated by the Alcohol Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission. Such stores must be located in counties that have authorized the sale of alcohol by the drink. Additionally, the golf course or marina must also be the holder of a mixed beverage or mixed beverage/caterer license.

The store will be subject to the same rules and regulations associated with the sale of alcohol. Employees must possess an employee license issued by the Commission, a separate license must be obtained for each location, and stores must purchase from a licensed wholesaler or distributor. The measure also defines “golf course” and “marina” as it applies to this section of law.
