## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1168 directs the State Department of Education to coordinate with the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to establish a microcredential program for science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) endorsement areas, including computer science. The measure also directs the Department and the Commission to convene a working group to determine how awarded microcredentials could be used for add-on endorsements for teachers, in lieu of certain subject area competency examinations and to meet certain professional development requirements.
