**Bill Analysis**

SB 1183 modifies language relating to city-county libraries. The measure requires income of city-county library systems to be deposited in a city-county library commission account in a bank whose deposits are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation and removes language specifying how funds are to be used. It also removes language requiring a city governing body and a board of county commissioners to approve a resolution prior to a city-county library accepting interests in real property and allows a city-county library commission to borrow on the credit of the commission for up to one year. The measure removes language requiring a city governing body and a board of county commissioners to approve a city-county library commission bringing another city into the system.
