Bill Analysis

SB 1189 prohibits the state from imposing a mandatory minimum sentence of 20 years or more or life imprisonment without the possibility of parole on any juvenile. The measure also requires the courts to consider additional factors as outlined in the measure as it relates to determining the appropriate sentence for a person who has been certified as an adult pursuant to certification procedures authorized in the Oklahoma Juvenile Code.
