**Bill Analysis**

SB 1224 directs the State Board of Education to solicit proposals for pilot projects to facilitate the coordination of health and educational services to families eligible for Medicaid. The pilot projects may address the needs of children under age 5, students who have dropped out of school, and adult members of families. The bill directs the Board to consider proposals in cooperation with personnel from the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
