**Bill Analysis**

SB 1228 broadens eligibility for the discounted application fee for a medical marijuana license. The measure allows 100% disabled veterans, terminally ill patients, and patients in hospice care to receive a discount on the license application. The measure also directs the State Department of Health to offer an expedited application review process for a medical marijuana license in which the Department shall mail the approval or denial letter to the applicant within 5 business days. The fee for the expedited review is set at \$80.00 for those eligible to receive a discount on the license application, and \$150 for all other applicants.
