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Bill Analysis

SB 1271 creates the Oklahoma Meat Consumer Protection Act. The measure strikes language prohibiting sellers of meat from committing certain acts related to advertising sales such as disparaging or degrading meat products, failing to have a sufficient quantity of the product represented as being for sale, using any price list or advertisement subject to changes without notice, misrepresenting savings made from a purchase, failing to disclose charges related to preparing the meat, and representing the price of any product to be offered for sale in units larger than one pound. The Act prohibits sellers of meat from failing to fully and conspicuously disclose the correct government grade for any product.

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
