Bill Analysis

SB 1274 repeals the Oklahoma Fuel Alcohol Act. The Act established a permit process individuals and businesses engaged in the business of manufacturing alcohol for use as a motor fuel whereby the individual or business must obtain permission from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms of the United States Department of the Treasury and State Department of Agriculture to engage in the practice.
