Bill Analysis

SB 1276 increases the percentage of funds required by the Physician Manpower Training Commission to be spent on the training of primary health care and family practice physicians for the rural and medically underserved areas of the state from 50% to 75%. The bill also modifies the membership of the Commission from two osteopathic physicians to three, and from two non-physician members to one.
