Bill Analysis

SB 1285 modifies the duties of the State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board by removing the requirement for the Board to establish open technology standards for state agencies, schedules for agencies to publish and update convenience information, conduct events and contests, and an application process to request the scheduled implementation of application programming interfaces. The measure also strikes language authorizing the creation of the State Government Employee Performance Transparency Pilot Program and transfers the 2nd Century Entrepreneurship Center from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce.

The measure also removes duties related to the State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board. The Board shall no longer grant an exemption to the requirement of each state agency to utilize the open portal system, consider or approve security protocols, or oversee the implementation of the plan of action developed by the Chief Information Officer.
