To implement and administer the program, SDE anticipates that the school district will submit an application to SDE for designation as a purple star campus. SDE staff will review and evaluate the application and make a determination if the school district meets the criteria and qualifies for the designation. The school districts may also incur cost to meet the requirements stated in the bill including among other things maintaining a website, maintaining a transition program and offering professional development.
