Bill Analysis

SB 1300 modifies the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP). The measure provides program qualification for students who were in the permanent custody of the Department of Human Services after completing the eighth grade or reaching the age of 13 and upon graduation and allows such students to enter participate in the program until the age of 21. Additionally, the measure directs students in the permanent custody of the Department of Human Services to execute agreements to participate in OHLAP upon entering the eighth grade or upon reaching the age of 13. The measure directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to coordinate with the Department of Human Services to assist such students in completing the agreements.
