Bill Analysis

SB 1303 modifies seatbelt requirements for passengers under the age of 16. Passengers under the age of 16 are required by the measure to wear a properly adjusted and fastened safety seat belt, unless the child is otherwise required to be secured by a child passenger restraint system. Drivers who fail to secure passengers under the age of 16 may be held liable for damages in civil proceedings.
