**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 1310 authorizes municipal governments may require owners of property to provide the contact information of persons or entities responsible for emergency contacts and property maintenance as well as the contact information of an instate person or entity authorized to receive notice and service of process in order to combat public nuisances, dilapidated properties, or unlawful conduct. Municipalities are prohibited from assessing any fees to enforce the provisions of the measure.

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
