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Bill Analysis

SB 1324 requires the Department of Public Safety to complete an investigation as it relates to investigating fraudulent applications for a driver license within 21 days of the application submission. The measure also modifies the application process by stating that an applicant must disclose whether he or she has been previously licensed as well as whether his or her license was suspended or revoked within the preceding 5 years. Additionally, the Department's review period for commercial driver license applicants is shortened from 10 years to 5 years.

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
