**Bill Analysis**

SB 1325 allows a student to enroll in a statewide virtual charter school if his or her parents or legal guardians are transferred or pending transfer to a military installation within the state while on active military duty. The measure directs statewide virtual charter schools to accept enrollment applications for such students by electronic means and requires parents or legal guardians of the students to provide proof of residence to the statewide virtual charter school within 10 days after the published arrival date. The measure defines what shall constitute proof of residence.
