**Bill Analysis**

SB 1329 removes the reporting requirement for state agencies to report state and country in which the company that is seeking or awarded work is headquartered as it relates to awarding contracts if the agency's annual payroll is less \$10 million. The measure also broadens the requirement for directors to justify any award made to any bidder other than the lowest bid to include Oklahoma companies as well.
